### 2022 Wine Social Dinner Scholarship Fundraiser

The Fund Raiser at Toscana's was a remarkable success. After two years of being unable to have an in-person event, the 2022 Wine Social and Dinner fundraiser was an incredible success. There were so many donations to the Silent Auction and the Fund in Need and so many participants that we exceeded by far the amounts we hoped to earn for our students who benefit from this fundraiser.

The total earned after all expenses were paid was 15,276.31! Wow! Not only did we all have a great time, but we can now add another scholarship to those we already give to young women to further their education. We will be able to fund 7 high school scholarships: 2 to Turlock High, 2 for Pitman High, 1 to Modesto High, 1 to Enochs High and added to our list, 1 to Ceres High. We will also be able to send 6 middle school girls to Tech Trek.

## Our Work continues...

#### The Scholarship Committee

Each year before Christmas, the Scholarship Committee begins its work by contacting the high schools involved and notifying the counselors of the scholarships available and the qualifications needed for the girls to have if they are going to apply. There are applications to be filled out and essays to be written by the young women applying.

The applications and essays are gathered and a committee of Pat Portwood, Wanda Bonnell, and Sheila Younkin assemble themselves to read and consider all the students have had to say. They winnow the applicants to a few from each high school and present the most deserving to the AAUW Board at the next meeting. At this Board meeting, usually in April, the recipients of each of our scholarships are chosen. They will be presented with their parents to the whole of the AAUW membership at the May Luncheon. At this time, each girl tells the membership of her hopes and dreams for college and beyond. A wonderful ending and beginning that is the result all our hard work of fund raising.

#### The Adventure of Tech Trek

This summer 2023, Tech Trek (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics

Camp for girls completing the seventh grade) will celebrate its 25th year. Created and implemented by Marie Wolbach at Stanford University in 1998, it spread throughout California and eventially to nine additional states. The California Tech Trek program is held on seven college campuses plus two Virtual camps, all coordinated and operated by AAUW volunteers.

AAUW branches appoint Tech Trek coordinators to work with teachers or counselors in schools to reach out to girls, parents and other branch members in the nomination process and selection process. Seventh grade girls nominated complete and submit an application and an essay online; the student's parent also submits an online application.

Modesto/Turlock Branch members from Modesto participating in the Zoom interview process were: Marylou Rousseau, Fran Ewald, Pam Mayne and Beverly Schlegel. Pat Portwood, Sheila Younkin, Mary Allen, Samantha Coughlin, and Valerie Doherty were the Branch members from Turlock who read applications and interviewed girls and parents and selected the participants.

Three girls from Modesto and one from Turlock participated in the Tech Trek Camp at CSU, Fresno, June12-June 18, 2022. One girl from Turlock participated in the Virtual Camp in the Summer 2022. All have reported truly favorable experiences.
